### **How to Break-glass with IntelConnect**

For those users who view Territory X-Ray Services' IntelRad PACS, should you wish to view images and reports referred by another practitioner, you can break glass .

- Go to <https://imaging.territoryxray.com.au> and log in with your account details
  1. Hit the break-glass(padlock) button at the top of the window next to where you enter patient details
  2. Then follow the instructions
  3. You need to type in the patient details correctly, ie Smith,John for name and 19801203 for DOB (YYYYMMDD)

## How to install IntelViewer and add a bookmark for Territory X-Ray Services

To install IntelViewer , go to  
<https://imaging.territoryxray.com.au/IntelViewer>

1. Open IntelViewer
2. *Edit Bookmarks*
3. *Add*
4. type in URL <https://imaging.territoryxray.com.au>
5. click on *Protect Bookmark*
6. Once you have signed in (this may upgrade IntelViewer to the latest version and you may require your department IT admin permission)
7. go to *Utilities*, select *Automatic Login* and re-type your Password – you no longer require to enter Password each time you use TXS bookmark in IntelViewer

## How to Break-glass in IntelViewer

For those users who view Territory X-Ray Services' IntelRad PACS, should you wish to view images and reports referred by another practitioner, you can break glass

1. Go to the Search tab in IntelViewer
2. Left-mouse button click on "Break-glass Access"
3. Agree to confidentiality statement
4. Left-mouse button click on " Patient name & date of birth"
5. Then Search for patient using Surname, Firstname and YYYYMMDD for date of birth eg for May 09, 2000 you would type 20000509
